HOLY FAMILY: JESUS, MARY, AND JOSEPH

This Sunday, one day after Christmas, we celebrate the feast of the Holy Family: Joseph, Mary, and Jesus. Being the Holy Family does not mean that they have no worries or anxieties or problems. We can see, in this Sunday's Gospel, the problem between parents and children, when Jesus and His parents were going to the Temple. It is not about who is right or wrong. Rather it is about a family going through the struggles and difficulties of life together.

The Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph is our family model, because they are a religious family who practiced their religion wholeheartedly. They were people with deep conviction who freely gave their love to God. They did not go to the temple because it was an obligation. They worshipped God because they had a living faith, and the Lord was the source of their strength.

Nowadays, parents have a difficult time bringing up their children, especially in giving them a religious upbringing. Getting them to come on time for Mass on Sunday is already difficult enough. Trying to have family prayers is really challenging because of how busy everyone is in the family. Parents have to be firm with their children in their religious upbringing like coming for Mass on Sundays and praying together as a family. It is not easy especially when parents themselves are so busy and children are so independent nowadays

Yet, without the religious dimension of the family life, then it is almost impossible to have family values. But if there is to be any family love, warmth, and unity, then God must be in the center of the family.

Our reflection is: how does our family look like? What should we do to make our family as the Holy Family?

SANTA FAMÍLIA: JESUS, MARIA E JOSÉ

Neste Domingo, um dia depois do Natal, celebramos a festa da Sagrada Família: José, Maria e Jesus. Ser a Sagrada Família não significa que não tenham preocupações, ansiedades ou problemas. Podemos ver, no Evangelho deste Domingo, o problema entre pais e filhos, quando Jesus e Seus pais iam ao Templo. Não se trata de quem está certo ou errado. Em vez disso, é sobre uma família passando por lutas e dificuldades da vida em conjunto.

A Sagrada Família de Jesus, Maria e José é o nosso modelo de família, porque são uma família religiosa que praticava a sua religião de todo o coração. Eram pessoas com profunda convicção que deram livremente seu amor a Deus. Eles não iam ao templo porque era uma obrigação. Eles adoravam a Deus porque tinham uma fé viva, e o Senhor era a fonte de sua força.

Hoje em dia, os pais têm dificuldade em criar seus filhos, especialmente em dar-lhes uma educação religiosa. Fazê-los chegar a tempo para a Missa no Domingo já é bastante difícil. Tentar fazer orações em família é realmente desafiador, por causa de como todos na família estão ocupados. Os pais devem ser firmes com seus filhos em sua educação religiosa, como ir à Missa aos Domingos e orar juntos como uma família. Não é fácil, especialmente quando os próprios pais estão tão ocupados e os filhos são tão independentes hoje em dia

No entanto, sem a dimensão religiosa da vida familiar, então é quase impossível ter valores familiares. Mas se deve haver algum amor familiar, cordialidade e unidade, então Deus deve estar no centro da família.

Nossa reflexão é: como é a nossa família? O que devemos fazer para tornar a nossa família a Sagrada Família?
